MOUNTAIN FLYING DISCLAIMER

To engage the flight instruction services of Blevins Enterprise, the student will need to sign and submit this mountain flying disclaimer as well as the flight instruction waiver.

While every effort will be made to make the course as beneficial as possible, certain elements are outside our control. These include, but are not limited to:

- **Weather.** Mountain flying is highly dependent on weather. Outside the summer months, there are more "no go" weekends than "go" weekends related to a course of this nature. This means flexibility in planning. In addition, weather conditions can change quickly, necessitating adjustments in the course. It is entirely possible the planned route cannot be flown. At the instructor's choice, changes may be made. There will be no refunds for changes to the planned route of flight or even the duration of the trip. Full payment will be considered non-refundable once the flight has left the Dallas area for the initial leg of the training.

In addition, turbulence is common occurrence in mountain flying. In fact, in the summer season, flights begin to experience moderate or greater levels of turbulence as early as noon simply due to thermal activity alone. Wind, thunderstorms, and ice can also be another factor in trip planning. That said, the instructor alone reserves all right to alter or cancel any portion of the trip at anytime. The student should understand this prior to engaging our services.

- **Aircraft Issues.** Blevins Enterprises is not responsible for the aircraft used for instruction. Should there be a maintenance problem on the trip, the student will be expected to handle this. As a result, the schedule may need to be substantially altered. Again, no adjustments in fee structure will occur should this happen. Mechanical issues are a fact of life in light aircraft operations. The student should understand the potential for instructional interruptions should mechanical issues surface.
- With the exception of the most dire circumstances, it is expected that the student will be PIC at all times.
- A flight instructional waiver form will be required.
- The fee for the two-day course is \$900. A \$450 deposit is required at the time of scheduling with the balance payable prior to departure. This deposit is refundable as follows:
 - If the student desires to cancel:
 - Prior to 14 days to departure = 100%
 - From 14 days to the time of departure = 50%

- If the instructor desires to cancel (most likely due to weather)
At any time prior to departure = 100%

Once the course has begun no refunds will be issued for any reason. The full \$900 will be non-refundable.
